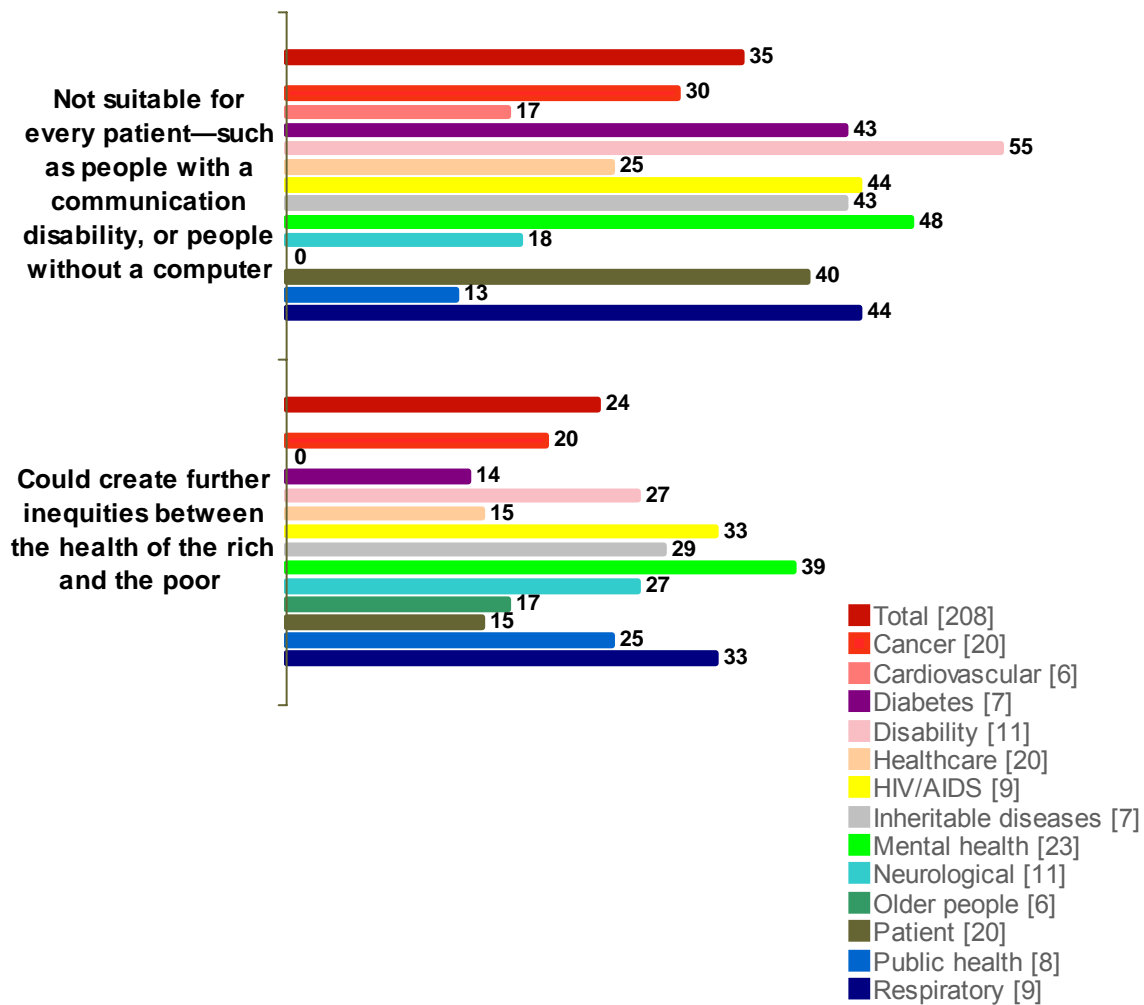


**NEGATIVE ASPECTS OF NATIONAL ELECTRONIC MEDICAL RECORDS SYSTEMS:

Footnotes:

Disability = all types, except learning disability.

EMR = electronic medical record.

Healthcare = health campaigners' interests in general healthcare and hospital-focused groups.

Inheritable = genetic, and (often) rare disorders.

Mental health = includes groups representing the interests of people with learning difficulties.

Neurological = all neurologically-related illnesses, except Alzheimer's disease.

Older people = includes two Alzheimer's disease groups.

Patient = organisations representing the interests of carers; children; patients; and people with congenital conditions. Includes statutory and voluntary groups.

Respiratory = includes asthma and allergy.
